




Potomac Edison's Instant Lighting Discounts

Contractor FAQs



1	Can I use the Instant Lighting Discount for my customers' projects?	Yes, Maryland Potomac Edison commercial and industrial customers replacing existing lighting with new LED lighting are eligible for an Instant Discount.
2	Are new construction projects eligible for these incentives?	No, but new construction projects are eligible for incentives through our standard Energy Solutions for Business Program. Visit energysaveMD-bizsolutions.com for more information.
3	What types of lighting projects can I use the Instant Lighting Discount for?	The Instant Lighting Discount is suitable for one-to-one retrofits, typically maintenance and smaller projects. Large projects will be considered; consult your preferred distributor for details.
4	What types of lighting products are eligible for the Instant Lighting Discount?	 LED High and Low Bay Fixtures E39 Mogul Base Lamps LED Linear Fixtures and Retrofit Kits LED Linear Tubes LED Exterior Wall Pack and Floods Lighting products must be listed on DLC 5.0 or 5.1, or ENERGY STAR® 1.0. Consult your distributor for a comprehensive list of their offerings.
5	Can I use the Instant Lighting Discount to purchase inventory for my company?	No, all lighting sold using this program should be installed within 90 days following the purchase.
6	Can I purchase products in bulk and use them at different customer locations?	No, purchases must be specific to the location where they are to be installed.
