Equipment Description	Incentive	Unit	Equipment & Eligibility Requirements
ENERGY STAR Dehumidifiers	\$25	Per Unit	Purchase and installation of a new dehumidifier meeting ENERGY STAR V5.0.
ENERGY STAR Water Coolers	\$50	Per Unit	Purchase and installation of an ENERGY STAR V3.0 water cooler.
Heat Pump Water Heaters	\$1,000	Per Unit	Purchase and installation of a Heat Pump domestic water heater in place of a standard electric water heater. Must meet ENERGY STAR criteria of EF or COP > 2.
Commercial Clothes Washers - CEE Tier 1	\$100	Per Unit	Purchase and installation of a clothes washer meeting ENERGY STAR Most Efficient of CEE Tier 1.
Commercial Clothes Washers - CEE Tier 2	\$200	Per Unit	Purchase and installation meeting or exceeding CEE Tier 2.
Non-Commercial Duty Clothes Dryers (w/ Moisture Sensor)	\$50	Per Unit	Purchase and installation of an ENERGY STAR rated clothes dryer with moisture sensor or a heat pump type clothes dryer.
Non-Commercial Duty Refrigerators Tier 2	\$100	Per Unit	Purchase and installation of a new refrigerator meeting either ENERGY STAR or CEE Tier 2.
Non-Commercial Duty Refrigerators Tier 3	\$100	Per Unit	Purchase and installation of a new refrigerator meeting CEE Tier 3.
Non-Commercial Duty ENERGY STAR Freezers	\$50	Per Unit	Purchase and installation of a new ENERGY STAR rated freezer.

Electric Vehicle Charger	\$700	Per Unit	Purchase and installation of a new ENERGY STAR certified AC Level 2 electric vehicle charger.
