The following measures fall under the custom program but are paid at the rates in the table below.

Equipment Description	Incentive	Unit	Equipment & Eligibility Requirements
Advanced Power Strips Tier 1&2	\$20	Per Unit	Purchase and use of a current-sensing master/controlled Advanced Power Strip (APS) in place of a standard power strip.
Monitors	\$5	Per Unit	Purchase and installation of a new monitor meeting ENERGY STAR V8.
Computers	\$5	Per Unit	Purchase and installation of a new computer meeting ENERGY STAR V8.
Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS)	\$40	Per kVA	Replacement or new installation of a UPS (less than 12 kW) that exceeds the minimum average efficiency standard as determined by Table 1 of the ENERGY STAR UPS standard. Table 2 of the standard shall be used in calculating the loading of the UPS.
Imaging	\$10	Per Unit	Purchase of ENERGY STAR rated imaging equipment including but not limited to scanners, copier, printers, fax machines and multi-function machines.
Small Network PC Controller	\$15	Per PC Controlled	The purchase and installation of network level software that controls desktop computers and monitors power settings with the network. Software must be capable of measuring and managing power consumption of each individual PC. Laptops are eligible but savings assume workstation includes desktop monitor, laptop computer with laptop screen in use.
ECM Evaporator Fan Motor	\$50	Per Unit	Purchase and installation of an ECM motor to replace a permanent split capacitor or shaded pole motor in a commercial refrigeration unit.
